#### **General Licence**

- Must apply by Jan. 29, 2018
- Application cost: \$150
- Licence cost: \$607/year
- Police record check

# **Limited licence**

- Must apply by Jan 29, 2018
- Cost of Application: \$150
- Cost of licence \$379/year
- You will require a Police record check
- You will have 5 years to apply for a General Licence

#### Limits of licence:

- Must be supervised by general licensee for many transactions
- Cannot sign a Status Certificate
- Cannot dispose of RF
